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## PORTABILITY NOTICE

### WHY MOVE?

A family may wish to move if they live in a high-poverty area. Studies show that children of families moving to the suburbs reach higher levels of academic achievement because of better school systems. Also, families experience increased satisfaction with neighborhood safety, lower crime rates, better public services, more shopping and increased job opportunities.

### RELOCATION AREAS

Families assisted under the Housing Choice Voucher Program may move anywhere in the United States, where there is a Housing Authority administering a Housing Choice Voucher program.

### PROCEDURES FOR EXERCISING PORTABILITY

This office is responsible for determining if there is a Housing Authority operating a Housing Choice Voucher Program in the area where the family wishes to move. After determining continued eligibility, the Section 8 office will then transfer the HUD Family Portability form to the new (receiving) Housing Authority.

The new Housing Authority may have different local requirements regarding such things as occupancy standards and reporting requirements. For example, a family may have to choose a different bedroom size, or may have to report family income within a different time frame. The receiving Housing Authority will conduct another interview with the family to explain how their program works.

### RENT CALCULATIONS UNDER PORTABILITY

The new Housing Authority's Payment Standards apply. This means the rent and utilities for the unit chosen in the new area must be within the limits that apply in that particular area.

The formula for deciding the family's portion of rent is the same. In other words, under the Housing Choice Voucher Program a family will pay the difference between the housing subsidy and the contract rent not to exceed 40% of their gross monthly income.

**All moves require close coordination between agencies, so please take no action without consulting this agency. Failure to follow program regulations may jeopardize your assistance. For further information concerning portability, contact your Rental Specialist (301) 883-5501.**
